

## Arrival by plane

### At Hamburg Airport

Please refer to the official website of Airport Hamburg for all travel information: [http://www.airport.de/index\\_en.phtml](http://www.airport.de/index_en.phtml)  
Air Berlin, for example, offers cheap inter-European flights to this airport. From here you can get with the shuttle service **110** to the metropolitan and suburban commuter railways **S1**, **S11** and **U1** at **OHLSDORF** station. If you wish to go directly to the conference venue, please use **U1** (eastbound to Ohlstedt or Großhansdorf) from **OHLSDORF** to **MESSBERG** (10<sup>th</sup> stop). From here it is a 10min walk to the venue.

### At Lübeck or any other German airport

Ryanair offers cheap flights to “Hamburg (Lübeck)”, which is actually Lübeck – about 100km afar from Hamburg! But they offer shuttle-services from Lübeck Airport to Hamburg coach station (Hamburg ZOB), which is very close to **HAMBURG-HAUPTBAHNHOF (Hbf)**, i.e. the central station. If there are no suitable flights to neither Hamburg nor Lübeck it should be no problem to get direct access to intercity-railway services from any major German airport.

## Arrival by railway

To book train tickets or view timetables, please refer to the official website of the German railway **DB**: <http://www.bahn.de>  
There are fast intercity-railway services (ICE or IC) to **HAMBURG-HAUPTBAHNHOF (Hbf)**, i.e. the central station. If you intend to go directly to the venue from here, please go to **Hauptbahnhof – SÜD** and use service **U1** (westbound to Norderstedt) to **MESSBERG** (2<sup>nd</sup> stop). ## Arrival by car

From South: If you drive on **A7**, change to **A1**, which leads to **A255** and shortly thereafter to **B4** (just keep on heading to **HH-Centrum**). After having arrived at **Deichtorplatz / Deichtortunnel**, keep south (near the harbour) and turn left to **Brooktorkai**. Then turn left to **Shanghai-Allee** and at the next junction right to **Koreastraße** where the International Maritime Museum is located. Parking spaces should be available throughout the Hafencity.

From North: Leave **A7** at slip road No. 28 (**Hamburg-Bahrenfeld**), head to **Centrum** and drive straight on **B431** for quite a while. When you see a large three-masted barque, turn right at the next junction (you will drive over a bridge and see large red brick historic wharf-houses). Drive straight on **Am Sandtorkai** until you reach **Brooktorkai**, turn right to **Osaka-Allee** and then turn left to **Koreastraße**, where the International Maritime Museum is located. Parking spaces should be available throughout the Hafencity.

Traffic might be restricted in the Hafencity, as this area is still under development. It is recommended to download also the city-map of Hamburg for your orientation.
